Resolutions (Voting Decisions)

- 1) CFMS Board Term: amended to July 1st June 31st (In Favour)
 - a) Resolution Passed
- 2) President/Past-president model: (Against)

President-president elect model proposed which would be difficult for 3 year programs because things would be inaccessible for the new president. The 3 year program already has barriers to being involved in CFMS- limited time for council to do things before clerkship compared to 4 year programs. With the new model, it would require students to come into med school knowing they were running for the CFMS positions for 3 year programs.

- a) Resolution Rejected (2/3) majority
- b) **Rationale:** proposed resolution disadvantaged 3-year schools and made the position inaccessible for most students in 3-year programs. UofC and MacMaster + several other delegates opposed the resolution.
- 3) Sunsetting/Restructuring RDs (*Pulled by BOD*)
 - Votes were quite split, did not end up voting because language deemed not ready for general voting. No changes made to regional director positions.
