- More money left in the bank account (up to a maximum of a 20000) = more money towards our graduation
- Total revenue for 2020 was \$89404.29. Estimated revenue for 2021 is \$99250, with the excess due to the Quality Money earned
- President: Kept identical to the 2019 budget
- VP External: CFMS meetings and PAD budgets are a little higher as they are still up in the air
- VP Finance: a little bit higher for bank fees with e transfer
- VP Academics: Up to date subscription has increased the budget
- VP SAW: About the same
- VP Events: About the same
- VP GH: Increased, however there might be overlap between VP SAW (student clubs) budget and this budget
